1. What kind of additional education or job/career training do you think you would like to start after you finish high school?
2. After you complete that education or training, what kind of job do you want to have?
3. What do you think are your strongest employment or vocational skills at this time?
4. What do you think are your strongest independent living skills?
5. What do you know about locating and using community resources?
6. Are there any travel or transportation skills you want to learn or improve?
7. What do you like to do in your free time for recreation/leisure?
8. What skills do you want to work on to help you get along better with other people?
9. Being an adult citizen in our society carries certain legal rights and responsibilities. What knowledge or skills do you think you have that will allow you to meet these obligations?
